1534 – Parliament's Act of Supremacy declared Henry VIII the supreme head of the Church of England. Henry then dissolved Monastic communities (monasteries, convents), distributing this wealth to the aristocracy (see Marvell, "On Appleton House"). 1544 – Succession Act established Mary and Elizabeth as heirs to Edward.
